HEAT CHECKS IN 164-03906 BRAKE DISC ASSEMBLY USED IN THE 40-106 WHEEL ASSEMBLY

PURPOSE: To advise Cheyenne I and II owners who have Cleveland wheel and brake assemblies 40-

106 and 30-106 on their aircraft that heat checks may develop on the wearing surfaces of

the brake disc, P/N 164-03906 (Piper P/N 754 626).

INSPECTION

PROCEDURE: At each periodic maintenance inspection, visually inspect both wearing surfaces of the

brake disc for heat checks.

ACCEPTANCE: Heat checks are considered to be superficial surface cracks and are not detrimental to the

integrity or performance of the braking system.

REJECTION: Replace brake disc if crack length exceeds 1.000 inch, or crack depth exceeds .395 inch.

If crack depth is not measurable, replace disc if crack length exceeds .500 inch.
