## FLASH AND/OR BONDING AGENT VARIATION OF P/N 154-03000

### A. APPLICABILITY

The following Parker Hannifin Corporation, Aircraft Wheel & Brake Division Service Bulletin Kit Parts Lists and Wheel Assemblies that incorporate the 154-03000, Molded Grease Seal.

#### **B. REASON**

The bonding agent is a product applied to the metal ring to enhance the adherence of the rubber to the metal at time of vulcanization. A very thin layer of rubber flash may extend onto the metal only (non-formed rubber) side of the ring around the ID or OD. Refer to Figure 1.

This PRM is to inform the end user of the variation without further action required.

#### C. AFFECT TO END USER

There is no affect for the end user. The seal will perform as designed.



MAXIMUM VARIATION: COMPLETE COVERAGE OF THE METAL PART OF THE SEAL.



MINIMUM VARIATION: CONDITION EXTENDS OVER ONTO THE METAL PART OF THE SEAL AROUND THE I.D. OR O.D.
